Tournament matches:  
EA has been chasing managers for list of teams that will take part. Need to field teams to encourage other clubs to attend our fund raising and they know Marston will attend their Tournament.  
TS half Marathon has raised £275 so far.
- 7.05** Xmas events:  
1. Horse racing night using DVD this costs £90. This could be a joint venture with Headington Quarry; or at the Marston Arms where there is option of using the hall. KC H had details of alternative horse racing from company called 'Moonlight Events' this involves a proactive racing game. This could take place at Mortimer Hall where a bar can be set up and all money from sale of alcohol comes to the club.  
2. A Family Quiz night with 'unwanted presents' to be distributed that are brought wrapped by everyone so everyone gets one. These are not bought specially but presents received that were not wanted.
